European Commission publishes the Internal Market scoreboard

Brussels: 1st February 2007

The European Commission publishes the [Internal Market scoreboard](#) [press release](#) [Report](#) that Member States have never performed better in implementing agreed Internal Market rules into national law and that on average that only 1.2% of Internal Market Directives for which the implementation deadline has passed are not currently written into national law an improvement since July 2006 when the average was 1.9%.
